Yusuf: Come on babe, don't be scared, I'll look after you.

Announcer: This is their story in their own words.

Yusuf and Vanessa Impro:

Yusuf: Really we should be at school now.

I'd like one Ayran. Just wait! Have you got any? I need money, I've only got 90 cents...

YUSUF: My friend, now, he's bustin' these full-on rhymes. Yeah I'm gonna be the shit, that sort of stuff. I'm killin' it. Used to be my thing too, but I was never that good. The rhymes come, but never so good. Just what I already know. But if you're talkin', like, R&B, some kinda love rap, that's a different story. I've got more of a feel for that, stuff comes to me. So I'm gonna make a song for her. So there's a girl singin' at the start, and then I come in, there's my lyrics, and then the girl comes in again, "Baby don't be sad, don't shed a tear, without you, I won't go away from here".

The tune is killer. I got it from a friend of mine, my brother, and he knows she and I are together. And he knows her too. He gave me that tune, just for me, just for her. I just had to make a song for her, but I didn't know what. And then all of a sudden I found it. And no-one's got it except me. And I don't want to fuck it up. I wanna make it for HER.

Vanessa: I feel like it was a flicker of fate that I found him. And everyday he proves it to me. Cos he's stressed out at home. Cos' his Dad's away and that sort of stuff. And he's got no-one. The other chicks say, fuck him! Vanessa. All of them think that. And his mates too. But inside, it says "No! Don't dump him". Cos' he doesn't have anyone else. That's why I stay. Cos' of me his life has changed. He's gettin' on better with his sister now, like heaps. His mum, every day she's proud of him, more and more. Cos' he gives her a kiss. Cos' he helps her. It feels like all that changed cos' of me. Like, the only reason I came is to bring them all back together. Just bein' there. Cos' his Dad's away and stuff. Cos' life is tough for him. That I've gotta take him under my wings and stuff

Yusuf and Vanessa Impro:

Yusuf: Yeah, let's go. Vanessa: yeah, let's go.

Yusuf: If I was the boss, do you know what I'd do? OK kids, that's it, go home, see you.

YUSUF: I was just lookin', you know, just lookin' to see who's comin'. And when I saw her I looked the other way, but my eyes just went back in her direction. Automatic. And then at recess of course I go lookin' for her. And then every recess and lunchtime.

VANESSA: I didn't take any notice of him then. I just didn't see him.

YUSUF: The first time I ring, it's the same day I get her number. The first time she doesn't answer. Me,I'm just normal. Then, like, suddenly she picks up. I get nervous.

So I say, hello. Big deep voice. She says, hey. Me, it's me, Yusuf. What you doin'? This and that. Stuff. Then I say to her, can I ring you often. And she says, yeah. Then we both hang up, and I'm jumpin' all over the place, right over the top. Cos' I'm so happy. And then I'm ringin' her every 5 minutes.

VANESSA: We were on the phone a long time, whoa.

YUSUF: Yeah man.

VANESSA: For hours. All through the night.

YUSUF: We talked heaps.

VANESSA: 'Bout everything that happened to us in our lives.

YUSUF: 'Bout how we're gonna get married.

YUSUF: Cos' I've got feelings for her.

VANESSA:that he wants to marry me.

YUSUF: She burnt me.

VANESSA: With a ciggie burnt his face. He's always puttin' his arms around me, kissin' me. I tell him, leave me alone, not interested. Cos' he does it so often. He won't stop. YUSUF: Yeah, but I don't feel like...

VANESSA: Then you'll never get it . No pain no gain Babe.

ROMEO AND JULIET

ROMEO: But love thee better than thou canst devise. Juliet! Till thou shalt know the reason of my love

YUSUF: In the beginning, when I told my Mum, she wasn't happy, Cos' Vanessa's German.

VANESSA: Hey, I don't tell my parents anything...

YUSUF: She's thinking, Vanessa will get pregnant, and then she'll piss off...

VANESSA: I don't want it to be that hard for him when I introduce him...

YUSUF: Cos' then she'll get the single mother's pension. Or they'll rip off the family, and we'll have to do too much housework. Muslims think like that.

VANESSA Cos' he was brought up that way. Your friends, your parents, like they all believe...

YUSUF The most important thing of all is, belief in the Prophet.

VANESSA: Like, what I 'm asking myself is, where do all the names come from? Everything in the world has a name. And the names all fit so perfectly: table, chair...everything fits so well!

YUSUF: You think that, cos' that's the way you were brought up.

VANESSA I'm waitin' downstairs. The lift opens. "Are you Vanessa?". And I'm like, yeah. And she says like, "I'm Yusuf's sister." Then she says like, "Come on up. Are you embarrassed or something?"

YUSUF: Seriously, when we broke up, it didn't bother me. Cos' I'd think to myself, it'll all be sweet. But after a while you realize you just can't get by without that person. And then on Saturday, we'd bought a packet of smokes. That was supposed to be for both of us. And then more than half are gone, and she takes the pack off me, cos' I'm smokin' too much. I'm playin' this computer game, I've gotta have a cigarette. And she straight to my sister.

VANESSA He says to me, never speak to me again, fuck off, he says all sorts of stuff to me...

YUSUF And the whole time she's sayin', come on, hit me, come on, hit me ...

VANESSA Yeah, cos' he pushed me away, really hard. So I say "Do you wanna hit me? Come on, hit me!" And he's like, "Shut your mouth! Or I'll hit you!" And I'm not gonna take that. Me, I wanna know, if I provoke him, is he gonna do that? Or not. Then he hits me. Rams my head into the windowframe. Grabs my head again and bashes it on a chair. And then he slaps me, hard.

I'm lyin' there on the ground. His sister comes in when he slaps me and kicks him out. I never thought he'd do it. Cos' he's promised me so often, "I'll never touch a hair on your head, not as long as I live. I love you way too much".

All that sort of stuff. Then he's out on his ass. Out in the stairwell.

YUSUF: First up I didn't know I'd done it, cos' often I don't do nothin'. Then I am out onto the fire-escape. That's when I know I can't live without her. I dunno what to do. I just think this pain has gotta stop. Should I jump off the window-ledge? Then I'm dead, and I don't feel pain no more. I go down, I see broken glass lyin' around. I cut myself. Then I go home. VANESSA Hey, if the subjects were more exciting, if it was something that was fun to do, like for instance Anne Frank, that stuff with the Jews, then I'd totally turn up.

YUSUF: Anne Frank? What's Anne Frank?

VANESSA Hitler. Anne Frank, the diary, that sorta stuff. I wanna know about that too.

YUSUF Actually I'm best in the class at maths, but I can't be asked, because on Thursdays I have three hours of maths in a row. That's bullshit. That's way too much!

YUSUF I got my scooter licence. Because of her I got it. On the third go. The first time I fucked it up. The second time I studied it with her, and the third time around we did it. My first scooter's gotta be real fresh. And I wanted a new one, had to be brand new. And that's why I chose this one..., firstly because it looks sick and because it's cheap.

Yusuf She gets cranky when I say, take a look at that dress she's got on.

She gets cranky all the time! Man, I have to listen to that all day.

VANESSA So with my pregnancy it was like, we all reckoned my best friend was pregnant, so we went to the doctor together. We both took the test to see if we were pregnant, and it comes up negative. Then we get a prescription for the pill. I get my period the same day, take the pill for 21 days — and my friend gets pregnant straight away, and she knew it. And then the doctor tells me I'm pregnant too.

YUSUF Prgenant yes, pregnant no ... I told my Mum about it, and she says, have an abortion, straight up. She was totally against it, full-on.

VANESSA Health insurance, hospital, I did it all on my own. But then my Mum found out.

YUSUF We actually wanted to keep the baby you know, we were really sad about it. But we couldn't do it...

VANESSA My Mum was really over the top, like fully. Scared for me, whatever. What if something happens to you, she keeps on saying' And then she asks me, when's the operation. So I'm like, tomorrow. And then my Mum like totally fell apart.

YUSUF I was with her the whole time. Except when they were operating on her. I went off for a bit, got some money, bought her some flowers. She didn't want the flowers. They were beautiful flowers. She wanted a rose instead.

VANESSA The same thing happened to my sister. But my Dad'd go off his head if he found out.

YUSUF To be honest, since this pregnancy thing happened, my mum and my sister have turned against her.

VANESSA It sorta changed ... everything.

YUSUF I haven't been home for five days. I ran away from home.

VANESSA Yeah, his sister, she comes across sweet, but really she's two-faced. And his mum too. We had a fight, totally over the top, us two. That was really bad. I was so drunk. I was gonna jump out of the window at his place and you konw what? What was really fuckin' fucked up was that his Mum rang my Mum the next day and told her everything.

YUSUF And on top of that she says we've gotta be apart.

VANESSA The message was like, her daughter should keep away from my son. Like...

YUSUF And then I had a fight with them and ran away. Every day my Mum's carryin' on, cryin', come back. And yesterday I say to her, give me some money. She's like: Why? You ran away. I'm like, I'm starvin'. Gimme money. She reckons: Nope. You've both hurt me. Badly. You've..No idea! I don't have to listen to this shit, I say, and take the money, and piss off straight away. Parents — they've got no idea, man. They were young once, but they still don't have a clue.

VANESSA: Right from the start his mother kept saying: Turkish girl! Well if that's what she thinks she should just go for it, and not be so two-faced. I changed him so much, all sorts of stuff. And what's the thanks I get? A kick in the guts.

YUSUF Sami and Emine, they get us food from somewhere. I can stay there for as long as I want, it's no problem. Well that's what I thought, but somehow I get the feeling it's stressing them out, me being there. They've got no money either, and they've got no electricity at home. They're living off mobile phones.

Vanessa: I was christened. My parents go to church every Sunday.

Yusuf: What they do in America, that's Catholic. You can go to see a priest and like talk to a wall. And Protestant is no wall. You can talk to the priest face-to-face.

Vanessa: I'm s'posed to be confirmed soon, but I don't wannna be. Altogether my sisters got, I dunno, about 1000 Euros. But I don't wanna do that, because then I'm going to be like totally churched! I couldn't be fucked.

Yusuf: Wait a moment. 1000 Euros? Can I do that?

Vanessa: No way. You're Muslim.

Yusuf: But can't you just do it, get the money, and then quit?

YUSUF When I pissed off from home we wanted to get our own flat. You gotta get permission from your parents. I talked to my Mum on the phone had a fight. I said to her, I'll get my own place whether you like it or not.

Vanessa: There's no way my Mum would let me leave home.

YUSUF The people at Social Security we're like, you're only 15, you can't get your own flat until you're 17. They reckon, if you're homeless, you can go to the emergency youth housing office and then maybe you'll get a place in a share flat. Takes a couple of weeks. I say, nah, I don't wanna share flat. Yeah...Maybe you'll get pregnant again, you never know. Then actually they'd have to give us a flat. And then, like, we'd get more money somehow.

VANESSA Flat, rent, they'd have to pay the lot. Furniture, the lot.

YUSUF ...rent, furniture, the lot.

VANESSA ...we'd get it all from the Youth Welfare...

YUSUF If we don't earn anything for a couple of months...

VANESSA ...they make it up...

YUSUF ...and then we'd have heaps of money. Sami is always talking about that. Six whole months he got no money at all from the job center and then all of a sudden 1800 Euros. So then he really spent up big.

YUSUF I've just been trying to convert my scooter into a Pegasus. A Pegasus scooter is always red in front and black at the back. And my scooter was red all over. I made it black at the back and left it red at the front. And then I didn't like it because there wasn't enough black at the back and the front was too red. The very next day I made the whole thing black. And fucked the whole thing up. If I could get 600 Euros for it now, honestly, I'd get rid of it.

YUSUF AND VANESSA IMPRO:

YUSUF: Let's go to Karstadt, I'll steal you some perfume. VANESSA: No! Yusuf, you've really gotta watch out with pinching stuff. YUSUF You've just gotta make sure you don't get caught.

YUSUF To tell the truth, I hate my sister more than anything. I don't even love her a little bit. I still love my Mum, but I hate her too. Really.

VANESSA So many young guys, if there's only women at home, they're the man of the house at 12, they've got a say. It's not like that for him. His mother says do this, do that and doesn't give him a chance. Like, they back him into a corner and then they're surprised when he doesn't come out. The other problem is, they never told him anything when he was younger. Like nothing!

YUSUF I didn't know what high school even was until I was in sixth grade. For example, womb, she told me what that is.

VANESSA The boy can't help it, but he's dumb. Because his parents didn't teach him anything. Everything he knows he got from his friends.

YUSUF If someone tried to come on to her, like, I'm not strong enough to do anything.

VANESSA To be honest, he is strong, he is strong but he doesn't have any confidence. That's the thing. He just like has no confidence.

YUSUF Because I was never supposed to get into fights. Because I had it drummed into me that I should never do that.

VANESSA With him, it's like, everyone reckons he's some kinda victim. But actually, in this world, we're all victims, you know. Because there's always someone stronger.

VANESSA We wanted to go to my sister's place, for a meal. The next thing we know there's a cop car next to us and they're saying, pull over.

YUSUF And they ask me, what did it cost? Yeah, the scooter 1000 on its own, and then the helmets and the mods and the plates on top of that... Right, he says, mods, hey?

VANESSA Yusuf, I missed 8 already!

YUSUF Then she gets done and she can pay up to 2500 Euro, easy.

VANESSA It's not so as though I'm skipping school. If I'm late in the morning it's because I've slept through my alarm. I hear the alarm go off, but then I turn it off in my sleep. My Dad's always asleep still too and my Mum's gone to work.

YUSUF When I first got to know her last year, she was always sleeping in, even then. She was late for school every day for 2 months at least.

VANESSA I wasn't late, I was skipping.

YUSUF Most of the time you skipped because you slept in.

VANESSA Oh, shut the fuck up!

LAWS 1

YUSUF In general, laws are a load of shit.

VANESSA Oh hallo? And why are laws a load of shit? You tell me.

YUSUF I guess everything here would be a mess, man.

VANESSA What's a mess.

YUSUF Everyone would kill everyone else.

VANESSA Yeah. No money. No nothing.

YUSUF No money, no nothing, everybody homeless.

VANESSA You see. Put it like this, the world would be destroyed.

YUSUF AND VANESSA IMPRO

YUSUF I'd like to take you out, properly, y'know, go and have a nice meal together. Spanish food is really good!

VANESSA I wouldn't feel comfortable with all those people around, posh like...
YUSUF She doesn't like fish, but me, I love paella, yum...and it's all yellow.
VANESSA Look, isn't it pretty!

YUSUF A wedding dress. See, when I get some money, I can buy it for you... She's not even listening to me..

YUSUF So on Friday I made it up with Mum, because I was starving. I promised her all this stuff, whatever, and everything was sorted out. And then yesterday, we have another fight. She says, "you can come home and have something to eat, but Vanessa's not welcome here". It was never like I wanted to hit my Mum before. Yesterday, I really wanna hit her. She gets scared and chucks me outta the flat. "Tonight you get your

things!"And last night, I went to pack my stuff up, I go up to the flat, and she's waiting downstairs...

VANESSA No-one's home, no-one's up in the flat...

YUSUF So I look, and there it is — "You bastard" — some shit like that — "You bastard Yusuf, never come home again, because of you Mum is in the hospital, there's something wrong with her heart, they're operating on her right now" and "go to your slut and if anything happens to Mum I swear I won't let you live."

VANESSA "You don't belong to the family no more."

YUSUF "Just fuck off. Never come near us again".

VANESSA "Here, leave the key on the table, take all your things and never darken our door again". So he should go begging on the street, so that he can eat.

YUSUF And then I go and start packin' my things. Fuck I was angry. I wrote her a letter, "Firstly you're a slut. The two of you are whores and I don't need you anymore." And then I wrote, "yeah, and my scooter got confiscated today"... what else did I write?

VANESSA You can assume it's going to cost 1000 Euro...

YUSUF Like, have fun paying the fine...And then I wrote "Fuck the two of you! I'll come back and get my things tonight and if you give me any shit when I come home I'll kick the door in and then I'll kill you both". I was so fucken' pissed off, because my sister called her a slut. No-one calls her a slut! And then I trashed the flat.

VANESSA Smashed everything. Took all her things, threw them on the floor, bathroom, make-up, perfume, everything on the ground, tipped out the washing powder, everything.

YUSUF The kids' room...

VANESSA All the CDs...

YUSUF CDs, everything on the ground,

VANESSA Clothes...

YUSUF Clothes, on the ground, all torn up. Everything all over the floor. We've got a balcony...

VANESSA He comes downstairs with his suitcase.

YUSUF We'd taken a lamp...

VANESSA He comes downstairs with the suitcase. From his own home!

YUSUF And this lamp always gave us light. We always used it. And I smashed that too.

VANESSA Babe, why haven't they called you?

FAITH III

YUSUF Our faith says that God created everything here to test us, until we die.

VANESSA If you do good, is the way shorter then?

YUSUF Not shorter, but wider.

VANESSA So what happens, if you're on that wider way, and you lose your balance, and fall?

YUSUF Then it's your bad luck. You're in Hell anyway.

YUSUF I rang Turkey, rang my Dad. I said to him, ring Grandad, tell him to ring the barber, and tell him to give me 50 Euros straight away, so that I can get something to eat. I'm starving to death here. And he says, let her alone, go from that girl, like ...

VANESSA "Don't fuck with your family like this".

Vanessa What direction are we going now? Yusuf I dunno. What are we doing actually?
